By 2015 Community HealthCorps will...

Have a presence in at least 500 communities, resulting in at least 4,400 national service participants having served over 5.5 million hours of service at community health centers through Community HealthCorps programs. Current day value of this service would be over \$126 million dollars.

Assist 700,000 individuals enroll in health insurance, health education and/or health center services, of which 280,000 will improve their utilization of health care services and over the long term will improve their health status and overall quality of life.

Leverage at least \$20 million dollars in educational scholarships awarded to national service participants seeking further education and/or careers in primary and preventive health care. Community HealthCorps will generate at least 250 new hires in health centers and 500 individuals who go for clinical training and return to a health center for a job post-service.

Develop a private growth strategy that will ensure fiscal and programmatic sustainability that promotes program growth and enhanced program quality.
